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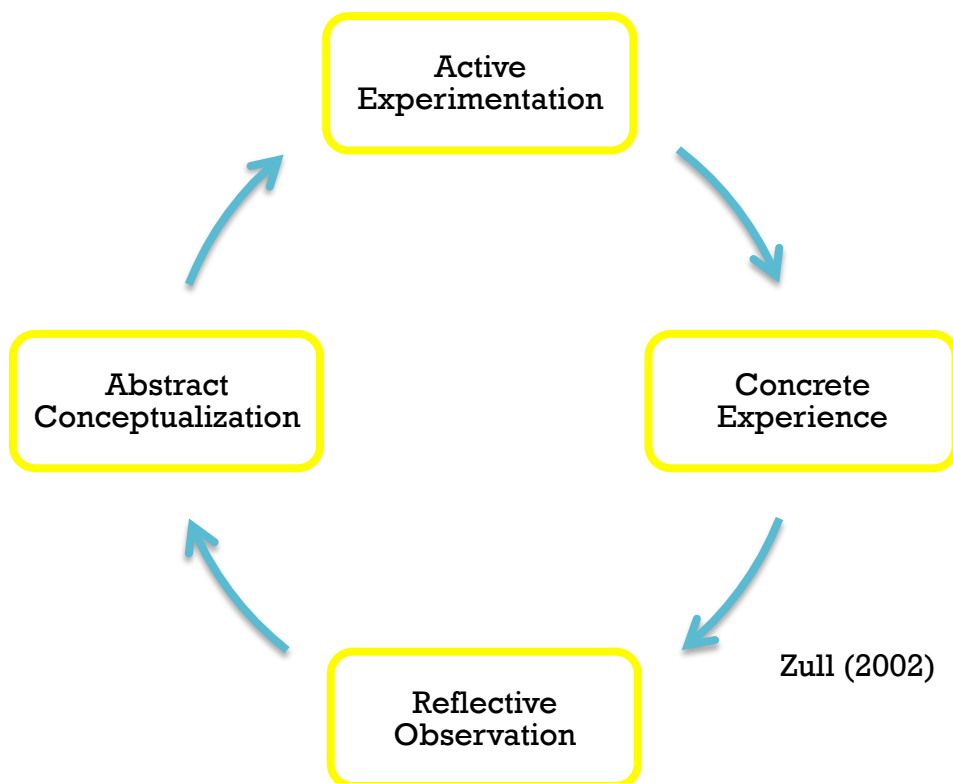
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The Learning Cycle

Learning Outcomes

Define what students and families should understand, experience, and/or take away from the program based on *what* and *how* they know and learn.

“Tell me and I’ll forget; show me and I may remember; but directly involve me, and I’ll make it my own” (Kegan & Lahey, 2001, p.10).
