1 Zoom Meeting

A Zoom event where one person hosts and all other participants have equal footing

2 Zoom Webinar \$

Webinar roles are separated into panelists (as well as hosts/co-host) who are able to present in the webinar, and attendees who can join in live polling, and Q&A

3 Google Meet

Part of the Google Suite platform. Free to use.
One host and participants can turn on/off their video

4 Webex/GoToMeeting \$


## Mastering Presentations



# Tips for college search students

- Large visits are usually done in webinar style, but if not, mute your mic

  - Be transparent with your expectations. Teamwork.


