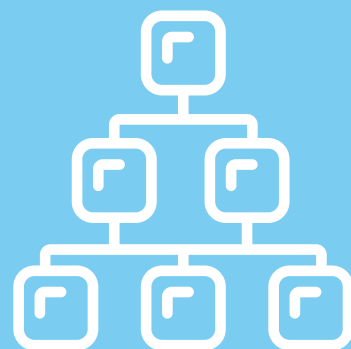


# IACAC'S NEW MEMBERSHIP MODEL

## GENERAL INFORMATION

In the Spring of 2021, the IACAC membership voted to approve a new model for membership. This new model will go into effect mid-September. Additionally, the membership voted to adjust the membership year to begin on June 1st starting in 2022. Therefore, the 2021-2022 membership year will run from September 15, 2021 to May 31, 2022 and the 2022-2023 membership year will run from June 1, 2022 to May 31, 2023. ## TEAM ACCOUNTS

Can utilize an administrative professional to manage the team account  
without counting against memberships  
Easily send a link to invite staff members to update their profiles  
Easily detach staff accounts and invite new staff when changes occur  
If you are the only member from your organization, you manage both the  
team account and your personal staff account (a little more work)

Only the team account renews/pays for membership  
Staff members can get a link from team account member to be added  
\*VERY IMPORTANT\* for each member to update entire profile accurately  
for voting verification
