GSU DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM (DDP)

- Partnership between GSU and 17 partner community colleges
- Makes the transfer process as seamless as possible
- DDP students earn two (TWO=DUAL) degrees, Associate and bachelor's
- DDP students SAVE MONEY and SAVE TIME

DDP REQUIREMENTS

- Between 12-45 college-level credit hours
- Enroll full-time
- Good academic standing
- Complete a DDP enrollment form
- Meetings with DDP Transfer Specialist
- Complete Associate degree before transfer







REQUIREMENTS – LESSONS LEARNED

- Adjusting credit hour eligibility maximum from 21 to 45 credits
- Need dedicated university staff to run the program and be the participants' advocate at the university, i.e. GSU DDP Transfer Specialist, at PSC campus
- Kresge grant with GSU commitment to sustain the program

DDP BENEFITS

- Guaranteed admission to GSU, application fee waived
- DDP Transfer Specialist will help map out academic path and share the "how to" of applying to a university
- Locked-in GSU tuition starting in the term of DDP enrollment
- Eligible to compete for the 50 GSU Promise Scholarships or the 13 DDP Honors Scholarships
- Discount for on-campus housing
- Individualized support from peer mentors
- Become a part of GSU community and utilize services










DDP'S MOST SUCCESSFUL PARTNERSHIP










DDP-PSC PIPELINE ENROLLMENT

KEY FACTORS FOR SUCCESS WITH PSC

• Transfer Specialist, Transfer Specialist, Transfer Specialist

- Self-starter, excellent at outreach
- Collaborative and friendly
- Rule follower
- Freezing tuition early
- Dedicated scholarships
- Role of GSU and the Liaisons
 - Train specialist well right from the start, give them the tools to do their job and then get out of their way







KEY FACTORS FOR SUCCESS WITH PSC

- Support from all levels at PSC
- Integrated to become a part of us
 - Office space, Website, Student forms, Datatel, modified HR file, Direct referrals
- Initial roll out of program plus sustaining its prominence
- Building on already good relations between GSU and PSC
- Unexpected outcome all PSC/GSU transfers benefit







OVERALL LESSONS LEARNED

- Appropriate referrals, and eligibility requirements
- Persisting in the midst of rapid change
- Be prepared to modify the program look for feedback going both directions
- Take your Liaison to lunch
